Rock Island High School Launches Entrepreneur Classroom

A ribbon-cutting ceremony was held on Thursday, Aug. 6 to celebrate the launch of the Rock Island High School Entrepreneur and Enterprise classroom.

Rock Island Rotary contributed \$10,000 to the project. Several club members are going to serve as mentors and help students learn all about building a business: from brainstorming, market research, human resources and business plan development. A classroom was renovated into a "Business Incubator" state-of-the-art classroom that will give students the space and freedom to collaborate in teams and work on their business model. Donations will also provide a pool of seed money for the teams to use as their ideas take shape. The course will culminate in "Pitch Week" where students offer their ideas to potential investors.
