Guest speaker at Rock Island Rotary today was David Porter, Illinois State Medical Society Vice-President of Health Policy Research & Advocacy. Mr. Porter is a graduate of Dennison University of Ohio with a degree in Political Science. He served in the Department of Health and Human Services under President George Bush (the 1<sup>st</sup>) and later worked for the American Medical Association in Chicago. In his current position with the Illinois State Medical Society, Mr. Porter is charged with monitoring and following legislations that impacts any area related to the medical field; educating doctors on the various laws and regulations that impact or may impact their practices; authoring and promoting legislation on behalf of the medical community; and acting as spokesman in support of or opposition to proposed legislation. He described the function of the ISMS as Advocating for Physicians and providing Education for Physicians. Mr. Porter divided his comments into three areas: 1) 2019 Legislation 2) Anticipated 2020 legislation; and 3) Answering questions from the audience. Regarding 2019 he noted that the most recent legislative session was an extremely active session with many pieces of important legislation enacted. He noted specifically the Society was successful in seeking legislation that prohibits anyone from smoking in a car in which minors are traveling. The new law prohibits any smoking if a passenger under the age of 18 is in the vehicle. He also was pleased that legislation was enacted that increased resources to provide better access to treatment for those suffering from substance abuse. Legislation was also passed that capped insulin costs for those suffering from diabetes at \$100 per month, with insurance required to pick up the rest of the cost. New laws were enacted making Illinois one of the few states that now have a 21-year-old age requirement for the purchase of tobacco and other products containing nicotine. The Society also led the fight against current vaping policies that Mr. Porter noted have caused five deaths in Illinois during the past year. There was a failed effort to ban all "flavored" vaping and tobacco productions, but he indicated the fight will continue next session. Mentioning that Illinois did legalize recreational marijuana as of January 2020, Porter said that the Society was successful in getting a warning label requirement on all sales of marijuana and limit on the serving size that can be sold. They also were successful in prohibiting ads for marijuana near school property and banned any advertisement targeting children. They also were successful in obtaining a ban on marijuana smoking in public places (similar to tobacco smoking regulations) and got an "opt out" option for cities that don't want to allow the manufacture or sale of marijuana. They also were able to enact a law prohibiting marijuana ads from stating that there are health benefits, or that smoking marijuana is good for you. Finally, they were able to obtain the establishment of a medical advisory committee to provide information directly to the governor regarding the use and regulation of marijuana. They worked for but failed to obtain a specific limitation on how much THC could be in a product sold in Illinois. For the coming 2020 legislative session Mr. Porter expects a continuation of the fight to ban flavored vaping, and said the Medical Society will be rolling out a campaign entitled, "Your Care Can't Wait", with the hope of reforming the current practice of insurance companies who require doctors to get prior approval before prescribing procedures and/or prescriptions they believe are needed by their patients. He said the red tape and delay is frustrating to doctors and dangerous for patients. The Society advocates that doctors should decide what is needed by their patients, not a clerk in an insurance office. Questions centered around the new marijuana laws, enforcement of driving impaired laws, and the impact the insurance industry is having in pushing the US toward a universal health care plan. It was a very interesting and enlightening program.
